Football

- The Band will be performing in the stands for this year's inaugural year of football season.
- Band students will need a pep band tshirt (more info and cost coming available soon) and BLACK athletic shorts of your choice
- Band students also need a flip folder and lyre for their instruments except for drummers (flip folders will stay with its drum). What you used in middle school should be fine. I would order from Playground Music or from Amazon
- Students should arrive at the Destin Middle School stadium at <u>6pm.</u> Games start at 7pm. We will be in need of chaperones to monitor our section, hand out water, and monitor the clean up before we exit.

Yearly Music Fees and Costs

- Music students have a \$150/year mandatory fundraising fee. Or \$15 per month. You may fundraise this amount, pay in full upfront or monthly, or a mix of both options. It's a flexible system to make it manageable for all families. But the goal is \$15 per month per student. Please see opportunities for fundraising on next slides.
- <u>BAND ONLY</u>: If you use a school owned instrument it is \$100 per year to cover cleaning, maintenance, and repairs. These instruments are percussion, tuba, euphonium, French horn, bassoon, oboe, bass clarinet, tenor and bari sax, etc. Essentially, anyone who does not own or rent their instrument from a local music store.
- Formal Uniforms are another mandatory cost. They are a one time purchase of \$70 and it will last your student all four years. If they need a new one due to growing or shrinking they will be able to purchase a new one at the start of each school year.
- Pep band uniform will be a tshirt and black athletic shorts. The tshirts will be available for purchase soon. We are trying to keep that cost under \$18 but more information will be going out soon. Black athletic shorts of your choice will need to be acquired on your own before the first football game on Sept 9th

Formal Uniforms

- The uniform does not need to be dry cleaned- can be washed at home!
- The pants and dresses will need to be hemmed. You can add in the hem service for \$15 or have it hemmed on your own.
- separate parts such as black socks or black tights and black dress shoes (no heels) will need to be purchased separately
- We will wear these uniforms for group competitions and performances. It is best to keep all parts (dress, shirt, vest, pants, socks, tights, shoes, etc) in a safe place in their own bag/on a hanger to grab and go.

Optional opportunities:

- -All County chorus is \$30 this year. I encourage many students to participate in these events. There are four evening rehearsals, one Sunday afternoon rehearsal, an all day off campus rehearsal, and a Monday night performance. This is a great experience. The fee covers their lunch and the cost we pay to their clinician. Peter Steenblick is the clinician this year. He is the director at UWF and he is always looking for scholarship recipients.... Seniors take note.
- -Prism concert to Florida State. This is the first week of December. We are only taking band students this year to cut down on transportation costs. The cost for this trip is still being configured but will likely be around \$50-\$60. More info to come. Will need two chaperones!!
- -Hamilton field trip to Birmingham, AL in January. Approximate cost including meals, hotel, bus, and tickets is \$350.
